Who is the Course for?

Do I need any prior experience? No formal qualifications are needed, just an interest in art.

What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: The course aims to encourage an adventurous and enquiring approach to the subject through the development of ideas, expression and practical skills within an understanding of past and contemporary art and design practice.

What topics will I cover? The disciplines include drawing, painting, printmaking, graphic design and sculpture. This offers a choice of techniques and materials with which to explore themes and to realise projects. Project briefs can be interpreted by students in a variety of ways.

What will the sessions consist of?

Students are supported as independent learners, developing an artistic and personal professionalism towards their studies and possible future careers in the arts. The AS Level course consists of two coursework units and one examination project taken at the end of the year.

Students can choose from a range of media such as water-colour, oils, acrylic paint, mono-prints, etching, collage, mixed media, pastel, charcoal, pen and ink, wire, clay, plaster, wood, found materials, textiles and digital photography and will work through a series of projects based on portrait, still-life, life-drawing and location studies.

How is the course assessed?

Tutor support is provided and towards the end of the course, students undertake an exam project, which together with coursework, is assessed at the end of the year.

How can I prepare for the course?

Collect and bring five images on one of the following topics: figures, landscapes or architecture. These can be sketches, photographs, articles and pictures of other artists' work.
