Who is the Course for?

Do I need any prior experience? This is the second year of the ILEX professional law qualification aimed at students who have already undertaken the Certificate course. Applications should be made by telephone in the first instance.

Will I need an Interview? Yes, college-based interview required.

What could I do next? Attainment of the full ILEX Diploma will give you the opportunity to progress on to the ILEX Level 6

What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: During this second year of the full ILEX qualification you will study 4 substantive Law subjects and 1 linked Practice paper.

What topics will I cover? You will study the following topics: Family Law; Family Practice; Law of Tort; Law of Contract and Land Law.

What will the sessions consist of?

You will be taught in a friendly environment that encourages participation in range of learning activities. Homework is essential for the successful completion of the course.

How is the course assessed?

The course is solely exam-based. You will sit 2 examinations in January 2012 and 3 examinations in June 2012. If you are successful in all 5 papers and have achieved the ILEX Certificate in Law and Practice, you will be awarded the ILEX Diploma in Law and Practice.

How can I prepare for the course?
