Who is the Course for?

What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: This one-year course covers basic mathematics for those who want to improve their skills. Numeracy plays a fundamental part in adult life. It is the ability to represent ideas, problems or situations using numerical information, and then to present results as solutions or conclusions. Effective numeracy skills support independent living and broaden the choices and opportunities available to individuals.

What topics will I cover? Topics covered include everyday arithmetical skills, fractions, decimals, percentages, common measures (money, time, weights etc), shape and space, data and statistical measures, charts and diagrams.

What will the sessions consist of?

Sessions will consist of worksheets, Puzzles, Presentations, Games and Exam practice

What to bring on the first night? An exercise book/paper and a folder to keep worksheets in.

How is the course assessed?

Assessment is by multiple-choice question in a 75 minute test, which can be taken when the tutor thinks you are ready. The tests are supplied by OCR.

How can I prepare for the course?

Key Facts
