Who is the Course for?

What are the aims of the course?

What topics will I cover?

At AS level, activities are based on the following topic areas: les medias, la vie culturelle, les loisirs, et la famille.

What will the sessions consist of?

Most lessons will include a variety of activities - expect the opportunity to speak in pairs or group work, undertake exercises to increase vocabulary, give oral presentations, explanation and revision of grammar, short written tasks and exercises.

How is the course assessed?

Assessment is by exam in the summer of 2012.
