What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: On this course you will acquire a basic knowledge and understanding of the language, practise with simple questions and basic facts in a range of familiar contexts, and develop a cultural, moral, ethical and social awareness of French-speaking countries.

What topics will I cover? There are core units of essentials and general information, plus two optional topics from travel, accommodation, food and drink, shopping, or services and emergencies.

What will the sessions consist of?

You will learn by speaking and listening, reading and writing the language. You will be taught in a friendly environment that encourages participation in a range of learning activities. Expect the opportunity to speak in pairs or group work, undertake exercises to increase vocabulary, explanation of basic grammar, short written tasks and exercises.

How is the course assessed?

There is no formal examination - you will be assessed by your tutor during class time.
