Who is the Course for?

Do I need any prior experience? Yes, you should have gained GCSE Italian at Grade B or above, or an equivalent, or have a good working knowledge of the language.

What could I do next? Italian A2

What are the aims of the course?

The main aims are to help you to communicate confidently, clearly and effectively in Italian through both the written and spoken word; to develop your understanding of the spoken and written forms of Italian; to help you develop critical insights into, and contact with, the contemporary society, cultural background and heritage of countries where Italian is spoken.

What topics will I cover?

At AS level, activities are based on the following topic areas: food, diet, health, housing, the family, media, education and employment, and social issues.

What will the sessions consist of?

Much use is made of Italian in the classroom. Most lessons will include a variety of activities - expect the opportunity to speak in pairs or group work, undertake exercises to increase vocabulary, give oral presentations, explanation and revision of grammar, short written tasks and exercises.

How is the course assessed?

Assessment is by exam in the summer of 2012:

Unit 1 Spoken Expression and Response in Italian

Unit 2 Understanding and written response in Italian

How can I prepare for the course?

Watch films and read books and newspapers in Italian. If possible, access Italian radio via the internet.
