Who is the Course for?

Do I need any prior experience? There are no minimum entry requirements. The course is suitable for any adult who is interested in learning BSL. Some practice outside lessons would be helpful.

Will I need an Interview? No

What could I do next? Successful completion of Level 1 can lead to progression to Levels 2 and 3.

What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: This course is designed to enable learners to communicate with deaf people in British Sign Language (BSL) on a range of topics that involve simple, everyday language use.

What topics will I cover?

- Learn to sign in BSL on the following topics: meeting people, getting around, interests & activities, your home, food, weather, transport, directions and numbers.
- Understand 'deaf awareness' and deaf culture
- Gain knowledge of the deaf community, how they view hearing people; the importance of their 'deaf world'.

What will the sessions consist of?

Session will include a range of activities including signing techniques, mock exams, practice and ongoing assessment.

How is the course assessed?

During the course, you will take units 101, 102 and 103 of Signature's BSL Level One exams. Success in these exams would open up future careers as interpreters, teachers of deaf children and support or social workers with deaf people.
