### Who is the Course for?

**Do I need any prior experience?** Yes, it is aimed at those already employed and working in roles that support learning in primary, secondary or special schools

**Will I need an Interview?** Initially you will need to complete an application form and then an interview will be arranged to assist your enrolment at the right level according to your job role

**What could I do next?** Level 3 Diploma in Specialist Support for Teaching and Learning in Schools

### What are the aims of the course?

**Course aim:** This qualification will provide you with an understanding of the knowledge needed when working directly with children or young people in school environments .

**What topics will I cover?** It includes learning about children & young people's development, safeguarding their welfare and communication & professional relationships.

**NB:** You will also need to obtain the written agreement of the Head Teacher to direct observation of your performance in your working environment.

### What will the sessions consist of?

This QCF qualification has 11 mandatory units. It will be taught over 30 sessions in college and individual workplace based assessments.

### How is the course assessed?
