Who is the Course for?

Do I need any prior experience? This course is suitable for graduate or non-graduate entrants who can be assessed at either Level 3 or Level 4. All trainers are required to demonstrate a minimum of Level 2 literacy, numeracy and ICT to achieve this qualification.

Will I need an Interview? Yes, you will need to meet with the tutor before you book on the course and bring your original qualification certificates with you.

What could I do next? Credits from this award can be carried forward to either the CTLLS or DTLLS qualification.

What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: This award is the starting point for anyone new to teaching in the post-16 Lifelong Learning Sector. It is aimed at those seeking an introduction to delivering teaching or training, and who are working, or wish to work, in Adult Education, Further Education, commerce, industry, the voluntary sector or public service. It confers a "threshold licence" to teach.

What topics will I cover? This is a single unit creating awareness of the key principles and practice of teaching and learning. It covers the difference between knowledge and skills acquisition, learning styles, inclusive education, differentiation and the application of skills in a classroom environment.

What will the sessions consist of?

This course will give the trainer the opportunity to preserve and build on existing good practice and to develop high quality teaching and training that helps all trainers to achieve to the best of their ability.

How is the course assessed?

The PTLLS unit is internally assessed. The overall grade is a pass, based upon the successful completion of the unit, a portfolio and practical teaching experience.
