Who is the Course for?

Do I need any prior experience? Yes, it is aimed at those already employed and working in roles that support learning in primary, secondary or special schools

Will I need an Interview? Initially you will need to complete an application form and then an interview will be arranged to assist your enrolment at the right level according to your job role

What could I do next? Level 3 Diploma in Specialist Support for Teaching and Learning in Schools

What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: This qualification will provide you with an understanding of the knowledge needed when working directly with children or young people in school environments .

What topics will I cover? It includes learning about children & young people's development, safeguarding their welfare and communication & professional relationships.

NB: You will also need to obtain the written agreement of the Head Teacher to direct observation of your performance in your working environment.

What will the sessions consist of?

This QCF qualification has 11 mandatory units. It will be taught over 30 sessions in college and individual workplace based assessments.

How is the course assessed?

This qualification will be assessed by a range of methods including direct observation within the workplace, a portfolio of evidence, written tasks as set by the examination board.
