Who is the Course for?

Do I need any prior experience? You will need a basic knowledge of a PC and be confident in navigating around the Microsoft Windows environment and the Internet. No prior web or software experience is needed to be successful on this course. No additional software needs to be purchased for this course.

What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: This course is aimed at students who wish to gain an understanding of how websites are designed and built, learning the skills to build and maintain their own sites. Students will gain confidence in using software to select, present, manipulate and amend data, and publish the website on the Internet. HTML and CSS concepts and features and website formatting are covered.

What topics will I cover? You will cover the history of the worldwide web, search engines, the planning stages of a website, browsers, HTML & CSS skills, the design process, graphics, links, navigation, page layout & the uploading of files.

What will the sessions consist of?

Each session will use a variety of activities including group discussion, demonstrations, project work and quizzes. Handouts will be given out each week to back up the content of the work covered within that session as well as tasks and projects to be completed in between sessions. Therefore students will be expected to spend some time away from the normal lesson time practicing and furthering their own study. Email support from the tutor is available throughout the course.

How is the course assessed?

There is no formal assessment on this course however at the end of course there is an informal assessment.
