Who is the Course for?

Do I need any prior experience? There are no specific entry requirements for this course.

Will I need an Interview? No, but telephone advice and guidance is available.

What could I do next? Digital Photography Workshop, Photoshop Elements, or Photography Portfolio Workshops.

What are the aims of the course?

Course aim: This is a creative and practical course which combines the technical aspects of digital photographic image making with the aesthetic qualities of images. You will have the opportunity to develop the practical skills to express your ideas through the media of digital photography.

What topics will I cover? You will spend some time understanding your camera's technical features— elements such as exposure, shutter speed, lens aperture, coverage, light metering, depth of field and so on, now usually available through a menu system in the camera. You will cover the creative side of various types of photographs such as portrait, landscape, action and nature photography.

What will the sessions consist of?

You will be taught in a friendly learning environment.

What to bring on the first night? A bridge camera or digital SLR, the manual, pens and paper.

How is the course assessed?

There are no exams or assessments on this course but there will be a mid-term photographic exercise.

How can I prepare for the course?

Familiarise yourself with the controls on your camera and find your manual.
