Achieved Transfer Grades A-E or D*-P?

Well done – you will be automatically enrolled into the 2nd year of your courses. If you have performed below target, spend some time thinking about an action plan for moving forward. There is still time to improve your performance so reflect on feedback you have had through the year to help guide you. You will be offered an opportunity to discuss progress, concerns, summer targets and future plans before the end of term with a member of staff, but you will not need to make a Transfer Review appointment during w/b 15 June.

I didn't pass all my subjects – what next?

Don't panic! Most students who fail to achieve a pass grade in one of their courses are able to progress into the second year with their remaining programme. Students continuing with 2 A Levels or a Double BTEC are required to pick up an additional course to enhance their future progression opportunities. Most students choose from the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) or our bespoke [Employability Programme](#). Tutors will advise you on the most appropriate option to support your future aims in your Transfer Review Meeting.

To prepare for your meeting, research both options and think about what you hope to do beyond Collyer's as this will help guide your discussion with your tutor. EPQ is most commonly chosen by students hoping to go to university but it is still possible to progress to higher education with just two A Levels. The Employability Programme will provide you with skills ready for the workplace or an apprenticeship, but some students take this course and progress to university.

Students who have not achieved an pass grade in one or more of their courses, must use MyProgress to make an appointment for a Remote Transfer Review Meeting with their tutor for Mon 15 or Tues 16 June (parents/carers are invited to join the meeting if they wish). The booking system will open at 5pm on Fri 12 June – book your appointment as soon as possible so that your tutor can set up a Zoom meeting. Use the link they send you to join the meeting on your allocated day and time.

Students are not usually permitted to repeat a course they have failed unless there are significant mitigating circumstances. In more complex circumstances (for example where a student has failed more than one course), Tutors may refer students to their Head of House for a follow-up remote appointment on either Wed 17 or Thurs 18 June. You can access the bookings for Head of House meetings from same tab but do not book an appointment with your HoH until you have seen your Tutor.
