If you have not yet registered then please note that the **form code** resets every 30 days and you will need to ask your tutor or the Library staff for a new code.







The personality questionnaire will help enhance your choice of subjects after college, increase your opportunities and help with eventual university and apprenticeship applications or job searches. When you access the careers library on UNIFROG you can see jobs grouped against your personality and own personal filters.



### The quiz assesses you against 4 personality scales:









- 1) Interacting with people
- 2) Interacting with the world
- 3) Making decisions
- 4) Making plans

# The quiz then informs you which is your closest personality type and which are other close matches

#### Your closest personality type

Like all of our personality type descriptions, this is an archetype. Depending on where you fall on each of the four scales, you might recognise yourself in more than one type - this can also change as you get older, or even depending on your mood or the situation. Also, two people with the same closest personality type can seem very different depending on things like their environment, values or interests. This description is a fun read that should encourage you to consider your skills from a new angle, and might teach you a few things about yourself - enjoy!
