16-19 Tuition Fund Statement

Autumn 2021



The 16-19 Tuition Fund is additional funding provided to allow 16-19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning caused by COVID-19. The 16-19 Tuition Fund is part of the £650 million schools and colleges Catch-up Premium and targets the most vulnerable and disadvantaged students.

Collyer's has been awarded £50k to pay for staffing to provide small group tutoring to students who require support. Any funds not spent on staffing will need to be returned to the DfE.

Who is eligible for support?

Level 2 students

All GCSE students received additional tuition for English Language and/or Maths during October and November in the run up to their Autumn re-sit. This support has now been paused until the publication of GCSE re-sit results in January 2022. After this time, Level 2 students will be eligible for two hours a week in one of the following ways:

- 2 hours of Maths
- 2 hours of English Language
- 1 hour of Maths and 1 hour of English Language

BTEC Level 2 subject specific support will also be available for some BTEC Level 2 students in January 2022.

Level 3 students

For a Level 3 student to receive additional tuition via the 16-19 Tuition Fund they must meet the following DfE criteria:

have achieved a 5 or below in GCSE Maths or GCSE English

To target students who require the most support we are prioritising students with disappointing PR1 grades.

Types of support available


All Level 2 students will automatically receive support in at least one of Maths or English Level 3 students who meet criteria will receive either:

- Subject specific support
- Studentship support

Further information covering the types of support that Level 3 students can be referred to is contained in the table below:

Support type	Guidance
	The student can be referred for subject specific support, for example support for Chemistry. Subject specific support sessions will be taught by a subject specialist*.
	The student can be referred for general studentship support. Studentship support sessions will primarily be provided by Collyer's Study Support Assistants.
