

Admissions Guidance

Entry requirements for courses are set by Collyer's Adult Education and Skills or, for qualification courses, may be set by the Awarding Organisation. See individual course pages for more information.

For recreational and non-qualification courses, all students must be aged 16 or over on the 31st August preceding the course start.

For qualification and funded courses, all students must be aged 19 or over on the 31st August preceding the course start.

We reserve the right to refuse admission to any student who has an unsatisfactory prior record or who breaches our Code of Conduct at any point.

For professional or work-related qualifications, Collyer's may require references from previous educational establishments or employers before agreeing admission to a course.

Collyer's will interview applicants for admission to courses, where appropriate, and will not admit applicants who are deemed to be unsuitable.
