### 1.0 Introduction

Following the changes made in the Education Act 2011 and subsequent changes to the Instrument and Articles of Government, a provision within Article 3.1.(a) requires the Governing Body to publish arrangements for obtaining the views of Staff and Students on the determination and periodic review of the educational character and mission of the institution and the oversight of its activities.

# 2.0 Purpose
