If you decide to go ahead, please complete the form, showing clearly which paper(s) you want reviewed, and make the payment. Please note the fee is per paper. The application can only be processed once the payment and completed form has been received.

Reviews of marking

- You will be able to see your marks as well as your grades for your qualifications
- If you're thinking about requesting a review of marking, please consider where your marks place you within the grade boundaries, published by the individual exam boards on their websites on results day. Remember that marks, and therefore grades, can go down as well as up following a review of marking.
- There are 2 reviews of marking services; priority and standard.
 - A Level and L3 the priority service closes at 12pm on Wednesday 19th August.
 - A Level and L3 standard service closes at 12pm on Wednesday 23rd September.
 - There is no priority service for GCSE/L2. Standard service closes at 12pm on Wednesday 23rd September.

During your time at College, you were encouraged to take an ABC approach to progression planning.

Ahead of results day, it's worth taking some time to think through each of your plans so that you're mentally ready to adapt quickly on the day, if you need to.

Preparing for A Level/L3 results day

- If you do not meet the grade requirements for either your firm or insurance offer, you will automatically be entered in to CLEARING. This allows you to apply for any places that are still available at most universities.
- You can apply for a course using Clearing if you're not already holding an offer from a university or college, and the course still has places.
- You can also use Clearing to apply to university after 30 June if you didn't receive, accept or decline any offers.

UCAS Hub

Log into the UCAS Hub on results day to check your application status:

If you meet your entry requirements, your place will be confirmed automatically. You do not need to do anything immediately. Wait for your university to contact you with next steps.

If you have missed your entry requirements, check UCAS Hub to see if you have still been offered your original first choice or have been automatically confirmed to your insurance choice. If you do not meet the grade requirements for either your firm or insurance offer, you will automatically be entered in to Clearing.

Once your status updates to "Unconditional Confirmed", take the following steps:

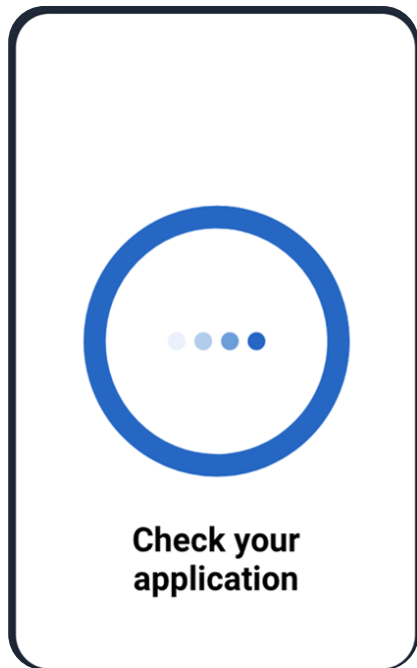
- Check your emails: Look out for a welcome pack or joining instructions from your chosen university.
- Confirm accommodation: Finalise any university halls or private housing arrangements.
- Provide proof of results: Occasionally, the university may request an official copy of your transcript of results.
- Apply or return to your existing student finance application to confirm your details: Ensure your maintenance and tuition fee loans are fully processed with [Student Finance England](#).
- Complete enrolment: Follow the university's instructions to verify your identity and officially register for your course.

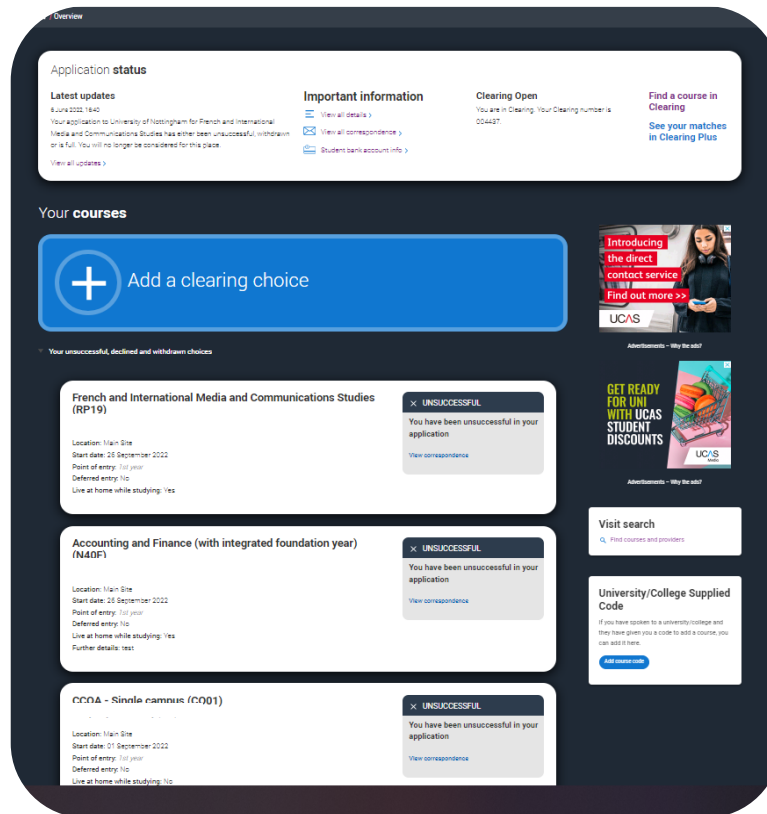

- If you become unplaced and enter Clearing, the 'see matches' button will be visible on your application status.

- Remember, courses in Clearing fill up quickly, and **you may not be contacted by a university or college you have expressed interest in.**

To add a Clearing choice you must have permission from the university or college to do so.

Ensure that you have contact the university or college and they have told you to add their courses as a Clearing choice. If you don't do this, your application may be delayed.

Once you've added your Clearing choice, you will not be able to change it until the university or college has made a decision. If you are accepted, you will be firmly committed to that course.

This tells the universities and colleges which year of the course you want to start, e.g. point of entry one is the first year of the course. If you wish to start in the first year of the course leave the box blank and you will automatically be considered for the first year. Enter 0 if you intend to take a foundation year – not all universities offer a foundation year so please check before applying.

If you've spoken to your chosen university or college and they are willing to consider your application to start the course after the first year, please enter the relevant number for the year, e.g. second year = 2, third year = 3, etc.

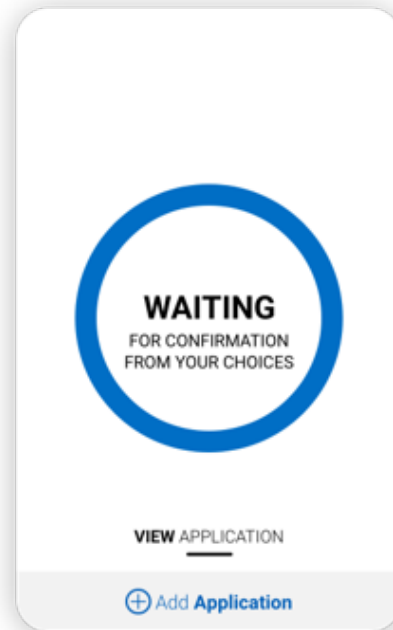

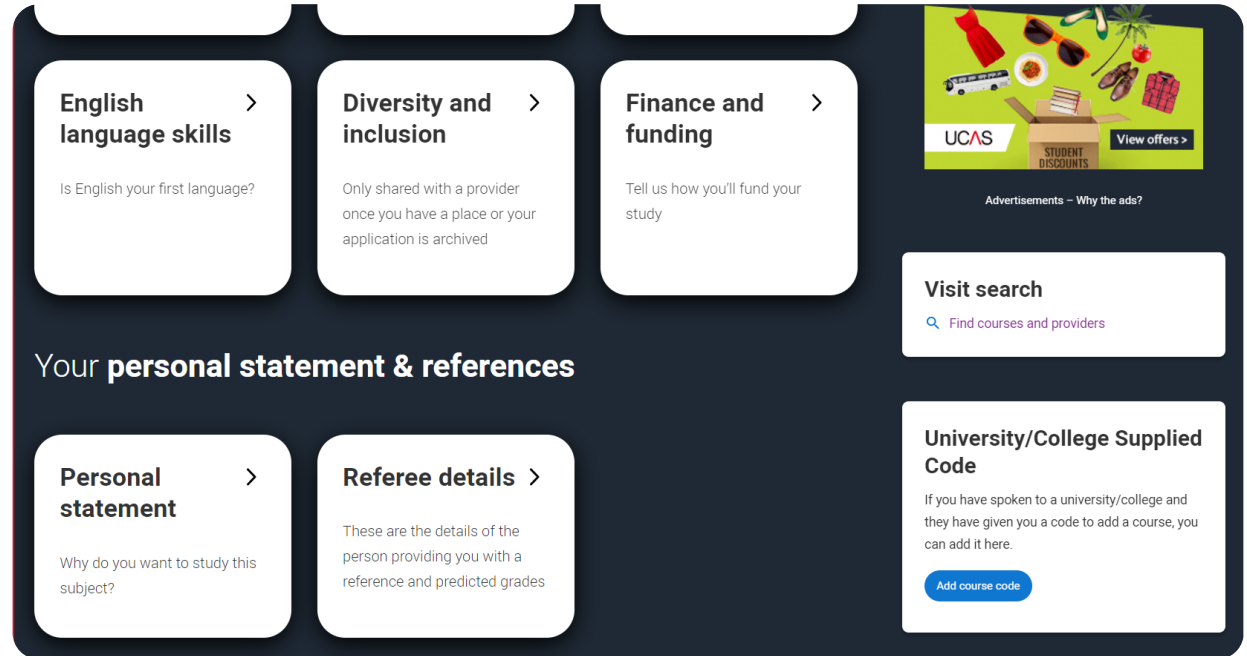

University/College Supplied Code

If the university or college has supplied you with a specific course code for a course available in Clearing, you enter it directly.

This may be the case for competitive courses where vacancies are rare and usually filled quickly.
